The most critical question for all thefamilies of persons with mental illness is" Who After us " for our family member.In the present busy life with urbanization & nuclear families expecting such support for PWMI is quite challenging. It will be ideal/ practical if a robust establishment works with right kind of ethos and established practices, to enable the kind of life we as parents have envisaged for our loved ones at their respective premises.

Concept of Inclusive living in a community

Families having persons with mental illness get isolated from the community due to stigma. Isolation hampers the recovery of the person and social life of family. Being part of a community enables to promote the well being of PwMI & family , improves overall quality of life.Families with similar needs living together builds an strong "Eco system required for the development of PwMI along with families".

Objective of Saksham-Sumana inclusive living

Families will move to cluster of houses within the residential complex. Sumana Trust will organize the support systems and engage the PwMIs through counselling, Psychotherapy, skill development, recreation and other support systems required to enhance their functionality. By this PwMIs can live productively with dignity (without ending up as homeless). All family live together and share common time and space with similar families. Persons with mental illness will share common space and time and rehabilitation support. Regular visits and supervision of Psychiatric medication for compliance is planned. First phase will be with 20 families and totally 40 families are planned in this residential complex .

Saksham-Sumana inclusive living project is formed by a team who are families with Persons with Mental Illness. This resource base will be further expanded with more new programs and a range of out reach activities which will not only provide support but also will augment the capabilities of the organization.
